Direct Object  
Noun

A direct object Noun receives the action of the verb directly and generally follows the verb.

**Answer Question: What is Juan Carlos taking?**

When dealing w/ a person or a pet it is always preceded by **[a]**. There is no English equivalent!

La Sra. Díaz visita **[a]** la Dra. Salas.

La Sra. Díaz visita el Café Delicias.

Direct Object Pronouns: <sup>are words that</sup> replace Direct Object Nouns.

## Direct Object Nouns

Maribel hace las maletas.

Felipe compra el sombrero.

Vicky tiene la llave.

## Singular

me → me  
you → te  
m. you (him), it → lo  
f. you (her), it → la

## Direct Object Pronouns

Maribel las hace.

Felipe lo compra.

Vicky la tiene.

## Plural

us → nos  
You (m. form), them (m.) → los  
You (f. formal), them (f.) → las
